## Funded Care

Our pricing structure allows us to provide flexible packages that incorporate the funding available to benefit the parents that can access it and those who are unable to get funding. The tables below show that we are competitive to other nurseries in our local area.

## Funded Options

### Option 1 – Over 3's - Mini Sessions 2.5 hours

These sessions are available for children without any extra costs. Subject to availability. Spaces are limited.

No extra care can be added to these sessions. Parent must supply nappies for these sessions.

### **Over 3's - 15 hours per week.**

Monday to Thursday

– Option 1 - 8.30am – 11.15am

- Option 2 - 12.30pm - 3.15pm

### Option 2 – Over 3's Funding- Reduction on Invoice

All sessions can be accessed if parents are happy to use the funding to reduce the cost of their invoice and pay the outstanding amount to the nursery. This includes the full day session.

### Option 3 – Over 9 Months and Over 2 Years Funding -Stretched School Days- 7.5 hour sessions

Monday to Thursday 8am – 3.30pm – Parents can choose 2 days per week, term time only (38 weeks per year)

Working Parents Funding - Under2's, Over 2's & Over 3's (30 hours per week).

Sessions can be extended to make the days longer and include holidays.

There are additional costs to use these longer sessions for funded care. Parents will be responsible for the extra costs.

They will be invoiced for the full cost of these sessions and the funding will be deducted from their invoice.

Term Time only fee £12 per day is chargeable if holidays are not included.

There is a consumables fee for the funded sessions of £3 per day this covers nappies, a hot lunch, a vegetable snack and a fruit snack.

Extra sessions are charged at the non-funded rates.

## Who is eligible for funding next term ?

### Over 3's funding

Every child who was born before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021 is entitled to 15 hours per week funding

### Over 2's and Over 3's funding

Funding for working parents whose child was born before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 and who fit the following Criteria.

Both parents work over 16 hours per week & both parents individually earn under £100K per year.

Apply online for the funding - Text the word TERRIFIC to 81025 – We will send you a text back asking for all the information you will need for the application to be processed.

We will apply for this on your behalf

You will need to email us the proof of the successful application and complete and return both of the funding forms and bring in photo identification for your child

Remember you need to reapply for funding code every 3 months

Please don't leave it until too late to apply for funding that you are entitled to. Applications need to be made by the nursery so please return all funding forms and identification before 20<sup>th</sup> March.

## General Information and Policies

We offer flexible childcare that you can mix and match sessions to meet your family's needs. We require a minimum of 2 sessions per week for all ages.

- Under 4's
  - School Day – 8.20am- 3.20pm or Full Day – 7.30am – 5.30pm
- Children at Wolfson Hillel School
  - Breakfast Club – 7.30am- 8.20am - For all years
  - Afternoon Pick Up- 3.30pm - 5.30pm – Nursery only

We are an all year nursery but we also offer a Term Time only option. This is a slightly higher cost per sessions but there are no charges during the holidays.

We are open all year with the exception of 3 days in August (these are not charged), 2 days in December (these are not charged) Jewish holidays (these are charged) and UK bank holidays (these are charged).

Jewish Holidays – Making it fair! If you use a day that is effected by more than 2 closures on one particular day for Jewish holidays in the same month, you will be able to have a complimentary day for each additional day that we are

closed. If you attend 4 days a week then you will be given a credit note for any additional days for the same day of the week. For example in October we are closed on 3 Thursdays for Yom Tov's. Therefore if you attend on a Thursday you will be offered 2 complimentary alternative days to use before the end of October. If your child attends the nursery 4 days a week term time only then you will be able to book the dates in the school holidays. These sessions must be booked in advanced, subject to availability. They must be used by the end of the month the festival. Parents using funded care will not be offered alternative dates for Jewish holidays.

There are no extra charges – For security, enrichment, inset day, food or anything else for our regular sessions.

Funding available - Terrific 2's, Over 9 months - 15 hours, Over 2's - 15 hours, Over 3's -15 hours and 30 hours (available the term after a child turns the age required)

Invoices - Invoices are calculated termly and split into equal monthly invoices emailed to parents in advance. The Autumn and Spring Term have 4 monthly invoices. The summer term has 3 monthly invoices plus a separate August invoice for those attending all year. Payments are due in advance on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

All invoices will be split into equal monthly payments for the term/ 3 or 4 month period. All Year Invoices are split as follows

- September, October, November & December
- January, February, March & April
- May, June, July & August

### With funding – Based on 2 days per week – 15 hours funding

30 hours funding is available for over 3's and the funding can be used over 52 weeks. We can claim the funding for up to 30 hours per week to be able to claim the maximum amount therefore reducing your bill further by using hours in school holidays that they haven't been used in the term. For example if you do 2 full days a week, you can claim 20 per week and use the 10 unclaimed hours a week to reduce the cost your care in the school holiday.

The funding is available 38 weeks per year. In the Autumn term there is usually more than 12 weeks so the extra weeks will be given to parents as a credit note on their account during this term.

Credit notes will also be provided for days in which the nursery is closed for the winter break, the summer break and for Yom Tovs if they attend nursery 4 days a week on an all year basis.

## Terms and Conditions

- All contracts are offered for a minimum term of 2 complete terms and a minimum of 2 days per week.
- Invoices are monthly in advance. Terms are invoiced in equal monthly charges. There are 4 payments each term. For the Summer Term there are 3 monthly payments. Those using all year care will be invoice separately for August.
- The price charged per day changes the term after the child has their second and third birthday.
- We require two complete months' written notice for all changes in childcare requirements. This includes  
Terminating childcare, changing days and reducing hours required. Notice should be served on the 1<sup>st</sup> of any month and allow for 2 complete calendar months to be invoiced (e.g. notice 1<sup>st</sup> June, last day 31<sup>st</sup> July)
- Fees are payable monthly in advance on the 1st of each calendar month.
- There is a £100 registration fee taken to reserve a space at the nursery. There is a £50 registration fee for breakfast club children. If your child starts at the nursery immediately (within 2 weeks) no charge is due.
- Fines will be charged for late payments - Up to 4 days late - no late charge/5 - 14 days late - £20 + 5% of outstanding balance charged per part fortnight/ 22 days or more late £20 + 10% of outstanding balance charged per part fortnight. More than 1 month late including late penalty fees, notice will be given.
- We reserve the right to give notice to a parent that is consistently late to pay their nursery fees. The service provided by Stars Nursery is comprehensive, including everything except sun cream, medication & baby milk.
- The nursery is unable to swap days. Extra days should be requested and additional charges should be paid in advance. Notice of a week is required to cancel ad hoc sessions without a charge.
- All addition days required will be charged at the session rate and do not qualify for any discounts.
- All types tax free childcare accepted.
- Only one discount can be applied to prices offered to each household.
- If a second sibling of 3 years and under enters the nursery, a discount of 10% will be applied to the lower of the two fees (not applicable for wrap around care).
- Policies are subject to review each term and prices to be reviewed each academic year.
- The nursery is closed on Jewish Holidays and bank holidays these are chargeable
- When possible the nursery will try to accommodate extra childcare needs, but priority will be given to children who attend the nursery for more the majority of their day.
- Extra charges will be applicable for extra childcare provided. This includes inset days, strike days, snow days and early closures for school events.
- Stars Nursery runs to support the parents of children that attend Wolfson Hillel School. Please note that the service that we provide compliments the school but we are not linked with the school in any way and operates as a separate private business.
- We reserve the right to cancel the service offered due to any potential health risks and government recommendations.
- In the event of recommendation (by the government or the local authority) that the nursery must close following an emergency that is likely to endanger the life of users. In the event of a forced close we will aim to offer care to all Key workers and parents in qualifying professions will be able to continue to use the service. If we cannot offer them the care due to our staffing restrictions then their fee will be reduced to 25%. For those that do not qualify as a key worker they will not be able to access the service and we will charge a reduced fee of 20% of their normal contracted fees.
