The funding is available for term time care only and the council dictate the length of each term and the amount provided to the settings in the area. It starts from the term after the child turns the relevant age. The council pay for 3 terms a year which they dictate the length of the term.

### Consumables Fee

To comply with the statutory guidance for funding nursery places we have a voluntary consumables fee of £7 for Afternoon sessions and School Day sessions and £10 per day for full day sessions to cover additional cost of the child's nursery care for food and resources applicable to receiving funding for childcare sessions. This charge is voluntary, however, without this payment parents must understand that we would struggle to be able to accept the funding to support the sessions that they receive. Additional sessions can only be accessed if the voluntary charge is paid for the sessions that are funded. If parents were unable/ unwilling to pay this fee we would need to stop accepting funding and this would make the costs of childcare rise for all those parents receiving funding.

Consumables fees are to cover the cost of the following items that the nursery provides breakfast, vegetable snack, fruit snack, biscuits, lunch, nappies, wipes, tissues, cooking ingredients.

If a parent does not wish to pay the voluntary fee they will be asked to supply toiletries (nappies, wipes, tissues, nappy bags) and all snacks and meals for their child. All food bought into the nursery must be Kosher (stamped), nut free and sealed in individual portions. Snacks can be prepared at home but parents must ensure that they are ready to eat in edible safe pieces. Unfortunately, we are unable to store food in a refrigerator or heat food due to rules of Kashrut. Snacks should be bought from home however parents and carers will not be able to prepare at home any fruit or vegetables to nursery that require supervision to prepare/cook (this includes all berries, leafy vegetables, broccoli). In order to compliment the children at nursery we ask for vegetables for morning snack and some fruit for the afternoon (no berries or grapes).



## Option E – Fully Flexible Sessions

If you would like to use the nursery with full flexibility we are able to give parents the choice to use the funding to reduce the cost of their childcare. You will be invoiced for the full amount of the childcare costs and you can reduce your payments by the funding amount that you are provided by the council.

## Who is eligible for funding ?

### Over 3's funding

Every child who was born before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 is entitled to 15 hours per week funding

#### What do you need to do?

We will apply for this on your behalf

You just need to complete and return both of the funding forms and bring in photo identification for your child

### Over 2's and Over 3's funding

Funding for working parents whose child was born before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 and who fit the following criteria.

Both parents work over 16 hours per week & both parents individually earn under £100K per year.

#### What do you need to do?

Apply online for the funding - Text the word TERRIFIC to 81025 – We will send you a text



back asking for all the information you will need for the application to be processed.  
We will apply for this on your behalf  
You will need to email us the proof of the successful application and complete and return both of the funding forms and bring in photo identification for your child

Remember you need to reapply for funding code every 3 months

Please don't leave it until too late to apply for funding that you are entitled to. Applications need to be made by the nursery so please return all funding forms and identification before 20<sup>th</sup> March.

### **General Information and Policies**

We offer flexible childcare that you can mix and match sessions to meet your family's needs. We require a minimum of 2 sessions per week for all ages.

- Under 4's
  - School Day –8.00am- 3.30pm
  - Breakfast Club 7.30am-8.20am
  - Afternoon Session – 12.30 – 4.15
  - Afternoon1 - from 3.30pm – 4.30pm
  - Afternoon 2 – from 4.30 – 5.30pm
- Children at Wolfson Hillel School
  - Breakfast Club – 7.30am- 8.20am - For all years
  - Afternoon Pick Up- 3.30pm - 5.30pm – Nursery only (available only to those who have previously been at Stars Nursery)

We are an all year nursery but we also offer a Term Time only option. This is a slightly higher cost per sessions but there are no charges during the holidays.

There are no extra charges – For security, enrichment, inset day, food or anything else for our regular sessions.

Funding available - Terrific 2's, Over 9 months - 30 hours, Over 2's - 30 hours, Over 3's -15 hours and 30 hours (available the term after a child turns the age required)

Invoices - Invoices are calculated termly and split into equal monthly invoices emailed to parents in advance. Funded Sessions are invoice separately to non-funded sessions. The Autumn and Spring Term have 4 monthly invoices. The summer term has 3 monthly invoices plus an August invoice for those attending all year. Payments are due in advance on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

All invoices will be split into equal monthly payments for the term/ 3 or 4 month period. All Year Invoices are split as follows

- September, October, November & December
- January, February, March & April
- May, June, July & August

### **Terms and Conditions**

- All contracts are offered for a minimum term of 2 complete terms and a minimum of 2 days per week.



- Invoices are monthly in advance. Terms are invoiced in equal monthly charges. There are 4 payments each term. For the Summer Term there are 3 monthly payments. Those using all year care will be invoice separately for August.
- The price charged per day changes the term after the child has their second and third birthday.
- We require two complete months' written notice for all changes in childcare requirements. This includes Terminating childcare, changing days and reducing hours required. Notice should be served on the 1<sup>st</sup> of any month and allow for 2 complete calendar months to be invoiced (e.g. notice 1<sup>st</sup> June, last day 31<sup>st</sup> July)
- Fees are payable monthly in advance on the 1st of each calendar month.
- There is a £100 registration fee taken to reserve a space at the nursery. There is a £50 registration fee for breakfast club children. If your child starts at the nursery immediately (within 2 weeks) no charge is due.
- Fines will be charged for late payments - Up to 4 days late - no late charge/5 - 14 days late - £20 + 5% of outstanding balance charged per part fortnight/ 22 days or more late £20 + 10% of outstanding balance charged per part fortnight. More than 1 month late including late penalty fees, notice will be given.
- We reserve the right to give notice to a parent that is consistently late to pay their nursery fees. The service provided by Stars Nursery is comprehensive, including everything except sun cream, medication & baby milk.
- The nursery is unable to swap days. Extra days should be requested and additional charges should be paid in advance. Notice of a week is required to cancel ad hoc sessions without a charge.
- All addition days required will be charged at the session rate and do not qualify for any discounts.
- All types tax free childcare accepted.
- Only one discount can be applied to prices offered to each household.
- If a second sibling of 3 years and under enters the nursery, a discount of 10% will be applied to the lower of the two fees (not applicable for wrap around care). There is no discount applied to funded childcare.
- Policies are subject to review each term and prices to be reviewed each academic year.
- The nursery is closed on Jewish Holidays and bank holidays these are chargeable
- When possible the nursery will try to accommodate extra childcare needs, but priority will be given to children who attend the nursery for more the majority of their day.
- Extra charges will be applicable for extra childcare provided. This includes inset days, strike days, snow days and early closures for school events.
- Stars Nursery runs to support the parents of children that attend Wolfson Hillel School. Please note that the service that we provide compliments the school but we are not linked with the school in any way and operates as a separate private business.
- We reserve the right to cancel the service offered due to any potential health risks and government recommendations.
- In the event of recommendation (by the government or the local authority ) that the nursery must close following an emergency that is likely to endanger the life of users. In the event of a forced close we will aim to offer care to all Key workers and parents in qualifying professions will be able to continue to use the service. If we cannot offer them the care due to our staffing restrictions then their fee will be reduced to 25%. For those that do not qualify as a key worker they will not be able to access the service and we will charge a reduced fee of 20% of their normal contracted fees.

### **Stars Nursery Calendar Dates - 2025/2026**

We are closed on the UK Bank Holidays, Jewish holidays. We close early at 4pm on the evening before all Jewish holidays and UK Bank Holidays and between Christmas and New Year. Below are the dates for All Year Care and shorter Term Time only Care. Extra dates can be added to extend care. This is subject to availability and will incur an addition ad hoc fee.

#### **Autumn Term**

All year – 1st September to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 – 18 weeks

Term Time Dates – Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September – Thursday 12th December – 14 weeks

There is funding available for 14 weeks during this term.
